From Toronto:

Hwy #401 west to London, exits at Colonel Talbot Rd (hwy #4).
Turn left (south) at the lights. The Best Western Stoneridge Inn is on the right hand side (west) of the road.

Note: Colonel Talbot Rd. is the next exit past Wellington Rd & the exit for Hwy 402.

From Chatham:

Highway 401 east to London, take Colonel Talbot Road/Highway 4 South (Exit 177A,) the hotel is located at the intersection of 401 and 4 on the southwest side.
